PRIVACY, PERSONAL DATA and TRANSPARENCY

Personal data provided to CRIT and come into CRIT's disposal in applying this call will be treated in accordance with Italian Decree no. 196/03 "Code regarding the protection of personal data". This section is an integral part of this call.

1. Preamble

Under Section 13 of Legislative Decree N. 196/2003 - "Code regarding the protection of personal data" CRIT, as the "controller" of the data processing, it is required to provide information about the use of their personal data.

2. Source of personal data
